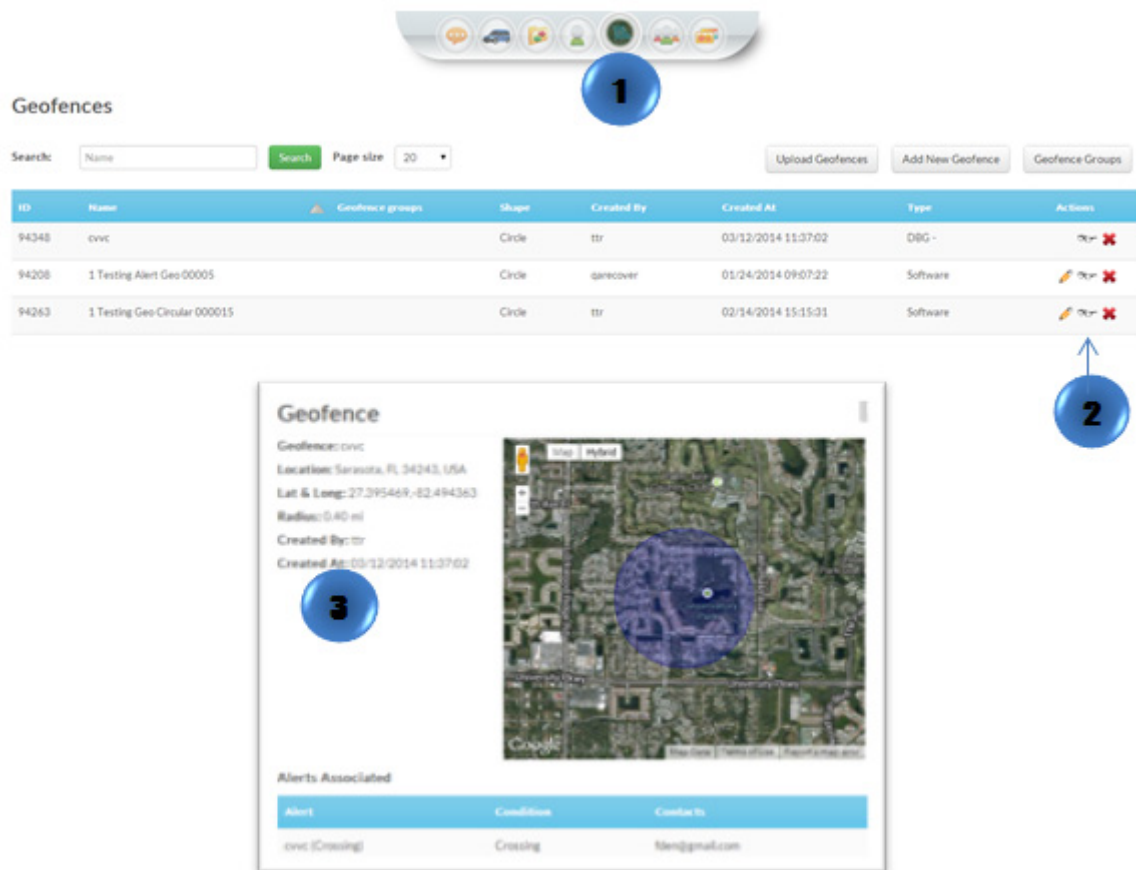


View a Geofence
